As the Regional Representative, he is responsible for 39 countries across the A-P Region, supporting country offices' activities and engaged in UN activities at global, reginal and country levels. IN 2019, he assisted organizing the Pacific Urban Forum, the Asia Pacific Urban Forum, national urban forums in various countries and other major events. At the regional level, he is currently co-leading the Issue-based Coalition (IBC) on Human Mobility and Urbanization.

Before joining UN-Habitat, Mr. Koresawa served at several ministries and institutions of the Japanese government since 1988 Some of most recent positions include Director for Management and Coordination at the Chubu (Central) Regional Development Bureau of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT), Director for SAR and International Cooperation at the Fire and Disaster Management Agency of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications, Director of Research at the Real Estate Transaction Improvement Organization. He has also served at several international organizations including UN-Habitat (Nairobi) (1991-1994), OECD (Paris) (1997-2000) and the Asian Disaster Reduction Center (Kobe) (2009-2012).

Mr. Koresawa earned master's degree in social development engineering from the Tokyo Institute of Technology and passed the Government examination in economics. He has been engaged in national, regional and urban development policies, land and real estate policies and disaster management policies in Japan and globally.
